A useful resource, available in PDF on the site, is the CollegeAIM —College Alcohol Intervention Matrix. It is a resource to help secondary and tertiary campuses address harmful and underage student drinking. Developed with leading college alcohol researchers and staff, it is an easy-to-use and comprehensive tool to identify effective alcohol interventions.
